O.T.

Gen 3:15	And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall crush thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.
Lev 17:11	For the life of the flesh is in the blood; and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul.
Jos 24:15	And if it seem evil unto you to serve the Lord, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell; but as for me and my house, we will serve Lord.
1 Sam 16:7	But the Lord said unto Samuel, Look not on his countenance, or on the height of his stature; because I have refused him: for the Lord seeth not as man seeth; for man looketh on the outward appearance but the Lord looketh on the heart.
Job 19:25-27	For I know that my Redeemer liveth, and he shall stand at the latter day upon the earth: and though after my skin, worms destroy this body, yet in my flesh I shall see God: whom I shall see for myself, and mine eyes shall behold, and not another; though my reins be consumed within me.
Ps 9:17	The wicked shall be turned into hell, and all the nations that forget God.
Ps 40:2,3	He brought me up out of an horrible pit, out of the miry clay, and set my feet upon a rock; and established my goings: and he hath put a new song in my mouth, even praise unto our God: many shall see it, and fear, and shall trust in the Lord.
Ps 51:4	Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done this evil in thy sight: that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, and be clear when thou judgest.
Ps 139:23,24	Search me, O God, and know my heart; try me, and know my thoughts; and see if there be any wicked way in me; and lead me in the way everlasting.
Pr 3:5,6	Trust in the Lord with all thine heart, and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he will shall direct thy paths.
Isa 1:18	Come now, let us reason together, saith the Lord: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool.

Isa 59:2	But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear.
Isa 64:6	But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf, and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away.
Jer 13:23	Can an Ethiopian change his skin, or the leopard his spots? Then may ye also do good, that are accustomed to do evil.
Jer 31:3	The Lord hath appeared of old unto me, saying, Yea I have loved thee with an everlasting love: therefore with loving kindness have I drawn thee.
Eze 3:18	When I say unto the wicked, Thou shalt surely die; and thou givest him not warning, nor speakest to warn the wicked from his wicked way, to save his life; the same wicked man shall die in his iniquity; but his blood will I require at thy hand.
