

The LAMB of God in Revelation Mentioned 28 times (7X4)

The precious title of the Lord Jesus as the "LAMB" is recorded '28' times in the book of Revelation and only '4' other times in all of the New Testament. (See **John 1:29, 36; Acts 8:32; 1 Peter 1:19**)

The number '4' is used in the Word of God particularly in reference to creation and perhaps speaks of universality.

There are four elements (earth, air, fire and water) four directions (east, west, north and south) and the Lord Jesus spoke of the four divisions of the night: evening, midnight, cock-crowing and morning. (**Mark 13:35**)

There are also four seasons (spring, summer, fall and winter) and the precious Word tells of the four divisions of the river that came out of Eden (Pison, Gihon, Tigris, and Euphrates).

The four living creatures of Revelation 4 are seen in relation to creation and the '24' elders (6X4) are there worshipping Him who sits on the throne. (**Rev 4:6-11**)

The number '7' speaks of spiritual perfection and the Word of God is filled with examples of this so only a few examples will be given.

"The words of the LORD are pure words, as silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified **seven** times." **Psalms 12:6**

The blood is recorded to have been sprinkled **seven** times on the great Day of Atonement speaking of the perfection of accomplished atonement:

1. On the mercy-seat (**Lev 16:14**)
2. Before the mercy-seat (**Lev 16:14**)
3. Before the veil (**Lev 16:17**)
4. On the horns of the golden altar (**Ex 30:10**)
5. On the horns of the brazen altar (**Lev 16:18**)
6. Round about upon the altar (**Lev 16:19**)
7. The blood that was left was poured out at the foot of the brazen altar (**Lev 9:9**)

No title concerning the Lord Jesus Christ arrests more interest than the winsome designation of the 'LAMB' of God. It is full of suggestiveness and brings at once to our minds and hearts the sacrificial character that our Lord assumed. It speaks of His submissive conformity to the divine will, the comeliness of His nature as meek, gentle and lowly in heart. It speaks of the beauty, purity and holiness of His unblemished person. From the beginning of the Word of God where Abel brought of the firstling of his flock until the marriage of the Lamb, the Scriptures bring this beautiful picture of the Lord Jesus before our hearts and minds. We bow before the absolute sufficiency of our God who could say to Abram on Mount Moriah, "My son, God will provide himself a lamb for a burnt offering. (**Genesis 22:8**) We view the appointed sacrifice of the Passover to secure deliverance from the bondage of Egypt and protection from the judgment of God. (**Exodus 12:3-4**)

It is therefore fitting, and again demonstrates to the willing mind, the perfection seen in the Word of God which closes telling of the Lamb who will be so honoured and have universal sway over heaven and earth.
