Exodus 6:6-8

Seven “I wills” from Three “I am the Lord”

- 6 Wherefore say unto the children of Israel, **I am the LORD**, and **I will** bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and **I will** rid you out of their bondage, and **I will** redeem you with a stretched out arm, and with great judgments:
- 7 And **I will** take you to me for a people, and **I will** be to you a God: and ye shall know that **I am the LORD** your God, which bringeth you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.
- 8 And **I will** bring you in unto the land, concerning the which I did swear to give it to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob; and **I will** give it you for an heritage: **I am the LORD**.

These will be fulfilled as earthly blessings for His earthly people. They cannot fail because they are from “I am the Lord”

Hebrews 8:4-13

Six “I WILLS” for the New Covenant

- 4 For if he were on earth, he should not be a priest, seeing that there are priests that offer gifts according to the law:
- 5 Who serve unto the example and shadow of heavenly things, as Moses was admonished of God when he was about to make the tabernacle: for, See, saith he, *that* thou make all things according to the pattern shewed to thee in the mount.
- 6 But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also he is the mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises.
- 7 For if that first *covenant* had been faultless, then should no place have been sought for the second.
- 8 For finding fault with them, he saith, Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, when **I will** make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah:
- 9 Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they continued not in my covenant, and I regarded them not, saith the Lord.
- 10 For this *is* the covenant that **I will** make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; **I will** put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and **I will** be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people:
- 11 And they shall not teach every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the Lord: for all shall know me, from the least to the greatest.
- 12 For **I will** be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities **will I** remember no more.
- 13 In that he saith, A new *covenant*, he hath made the first old. Now that which decayeth and waxeth old *is* ready to vanish away.

These go with Exodus 6, the first/old and the last/new covenant.

Ephesians 1:1 – 14

Every Heavenly/Spiritual Blessing from our God and Father

- 1 Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, to the saints which are at Ephesus, and to the faithful in Christ Jesus:
- 2 Grace *be* to you, and peace, from God our Father, and *from* the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 3 Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly *places* in Christ:
- 4 According as he hath **chosen** us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be **holy and without blame before him in love:**
- 5 Having **predestinated us unto the adoption of children** by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will,
- 6 To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us **accepted in the beloved.**
- 7 In whom we have **redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins**, according to the riches of his grace;
- 8 Wherein he hath abounded toward us in all wisdom and prudence;
- 9 Having **made known** unto us the mystery of his will, according to his good pleasure which he hath purposed in himself:
- 10 That in the dispensation of the fulness of times he might **gather together in one all things in Christ**, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; *even* in him:
- 11 In whom also we have **obtained an inheritance**, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will:
- 12 That we should be to the praise of his glory, who first trusted in Christ.
- 13 In whom ye also *trusted*, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were **sealed with that holy Spirit of promise**,
- 14 Which is the **earnest of our inheritance** until the **redemption of the purchased possession**, unto the praise of his glory.

We have these and they will be complete in a coming day and cannot fail because they are from the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Exodus 31

Six “I have’s” from “I am the Lord”

- 1 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,
- 2 See, **I have** called by name Bezaleel the son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah:
- 3 And **I have** filled him with the spirit of God, in wisdom, and in understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship,
- 4 To devise cunning works, to work in gold, and in silver, and in brass,
- 5 And in cutting of stones, to set *them*, and in carving of timber, to work in all manner of workmanship.
- 6 And I, behold, **I have** given with him Aholiab, the son of Ahisamach, of the tribe of Dan: and in the hearts of all that are wise hearted **I have** put wisdom, that they may make all that **I have** commanded thee;
- 7 The tabernacle of the congregation, and the ark of the testimony, and the mercy seat that *is* thereupon, and all the furniture of the tabernacle,
- 8 And the table and his furniture, and the pure candlestick with all his furniture, and the altar of incense,
- 9 And the altar of burnt offering with all his furniture, and the laver and his foot,
- 10 And the cloths of service, and the holy garments for Aaron the priest, and the garments of his sons, to minister in the priest’s office,
- 11 And the anointing oil, and sweet incense for the holy *place*: according to all that **I have** commanded thee shall they do.
- 12 And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,
- 13 Speak thou also unto the children of Israel, saying, Verily my sabbaths ye shall keep: for it *is* a sign between me and you throughout your generations; that ye may know that **I am the LORD** that doth sanctify you.
- 14 Ye shall keep the sabbath therefore; for it *is* holy unto you: every one that defileth it shall surely be put to death: for whosoever doeth *any* work therein, that soul shall be cut off from among his people.

- 15 Six days may work be done; but in the seventh *is* the sabbath of rest, holy to the LORD: whosoever doeth *any* work in the sabbath day, he shall surely be put to death.
- 16 Wherefore the children of Israel shall keep the sabbath, to observe the sabbath throughout their generations, *for* a perpetual covenant.
- 17 It *is* a sign between me and the children of Israel for ever: for *in* six days the LORD made heaven and earth, and on the seventh day he rested, and was refreshed.
- 18 And he gave unto Moses, when he had made an end of communing with him upon mount Sinai, two tables of testimony, tables of stone, written with the finger of God.

The provisions of God cannot fail because they are spoken by “I am the Lord”.

John 17

“I have” in the Lord’s Prayer

- 1 These words spake Jesus, and lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, Father, the hour is come; glorify thy Son, that thy Son also may glorify thee:
- 2 As thou hast given him power over all flesh, that he should give eternal life to as many as thou hast given him.
- 3 And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent.
- 4 **I have glorified thee** on the earth: **I have finished the work** which thou gavest me to do.
- 5 And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was.
- 6 **I have manifested thy name** unto the men which thou gavest me out of the world: thine they were, and thou gavest them me; and they have kept thy word.
- 7 Now they have known that all things whatsoever thou hast given me are of thee.
- 8 For **I have given unto them the words** which thou gavest me; and they have received *them*, and have known surely that I came out from thee, and they have believed that thou didst send me.
- 9 I pray for them: I pray not for the world, but for them which thou hast given me; for they are thine.
- 10 And all mine are thine, and thine are mine; and I am glorified in them.
- 11 And now I am no more in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to thee. Holy Father, keep through thine own name those whom thou hast given me, that they may be one, as we *are*.
- 12 While I was with them in the world, I kept them in thy name: those that thou gavest me **I have kept**, and none of them is lost, but the son of perdition; that the scripture might be fulfilled.
- 13 And now come I to thee; and these things I speak in the world, that they might have my joy fulfilled in themselves.
- 14 **I have given them thy word**; and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.

- 15 I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil.
- 16 They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.
- 17 Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.
- 18 As thou hast sent me into the world, even so **have I also sent them into the world.**
- 19 And for their sakes I sanctify myself, that they also might be sanctified through the truth.
- 20 Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word;
- 21 That they all may be one; as thou, Father, *art* in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me.
- 22 And **the glory which thou gavest me I have given them**; that they may be one, even as we are one:
- 23 I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me.
- 24 Father, I will that they also, whom thou hast given me, be with me where I am; that they may behold my glory, which thou hast given me: for thou lovedst me before the foundation of the world.
- 25 O righteous Father, the world hath not known thee: but **I have known thee**, and these have known that thou hast sent me.
- 26 And **I have declared unto them thy name**, and will declare *it*: that the love wherewith thou hast loved me may be in them, and I in them.

These we have and will not fail either. 6 "I have's" apply to us and 4 are what He has done in obedience to His Father.

1 John 1:6-10 (Five "ifs")

- 6 **If we say that we have fellowship** with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth:
- 7 But **if we walk in the light**, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.
- 8 **If we say that we have no sin**, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.
- 9 **If we confess our sins**, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- 10 **If we say that we have not sinned**, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.

Unlike the "I wills" and "I haves," the "ifs" depend on us.

1 John 5 (Seven "We Knows")

- 1 Whosoever believeth that Jesus is the Christ is born of God: and every one that loveth him that begat loveth him also that is begotten of him.
- 2 By this **we know** that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments.
- 3 For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.
- 4 For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, *even* our faith.
- 5 Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?
- 6 This is he that came by water and blood, *even* Jesus Christ; not by water only, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit that beareth witness, because the Spirit is truth.

- 7 For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one.
- 8 And there are three that bear witness in earth, the Spirit, and the water, and the blood: and these three agree in one.
- 9 If we receive the witness of men, the witness of God is greater: for this is the witness of God which he hath testified of his Son.
- 10 He that believeth on the Son of God hath the witness in himself: he that believeth not God hath made him a liar; because he believeth not the record that God gave of his Son.
- 11 And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son.
- 12 He that hath the Son hath life; *and* he that hath not the Son of God hath not life.
- 13 These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that **ye may know** that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.
- 14 And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us:
- 15 And if **we know** that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, **we know** that we have the petitions that we desired of him.
- 16 If any man see his brother sin a sin *which is* not unto death, he shall ask, and he shall give him life for them that sin not unto death. There is a sin unto death: I do not say that he shall pray for it.
- 17 All unrighteousness is sin: and there is a sin not unto death.
- 18 **We know** that whosoever is born of God sinneth not; but he that is begotten of God keepeth himself, and that wicked one toucheth him not.
- 19 *And* **we know** that we are of God, and the whole world lieth in wickedness.
- 20 And **we know** that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, *even* in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life.
- 21 Little children, keep yourselves from idols. Amen.

John's epistle begins with five "ifs" but it ends with seven "we knows." We know because of the witnesses.
